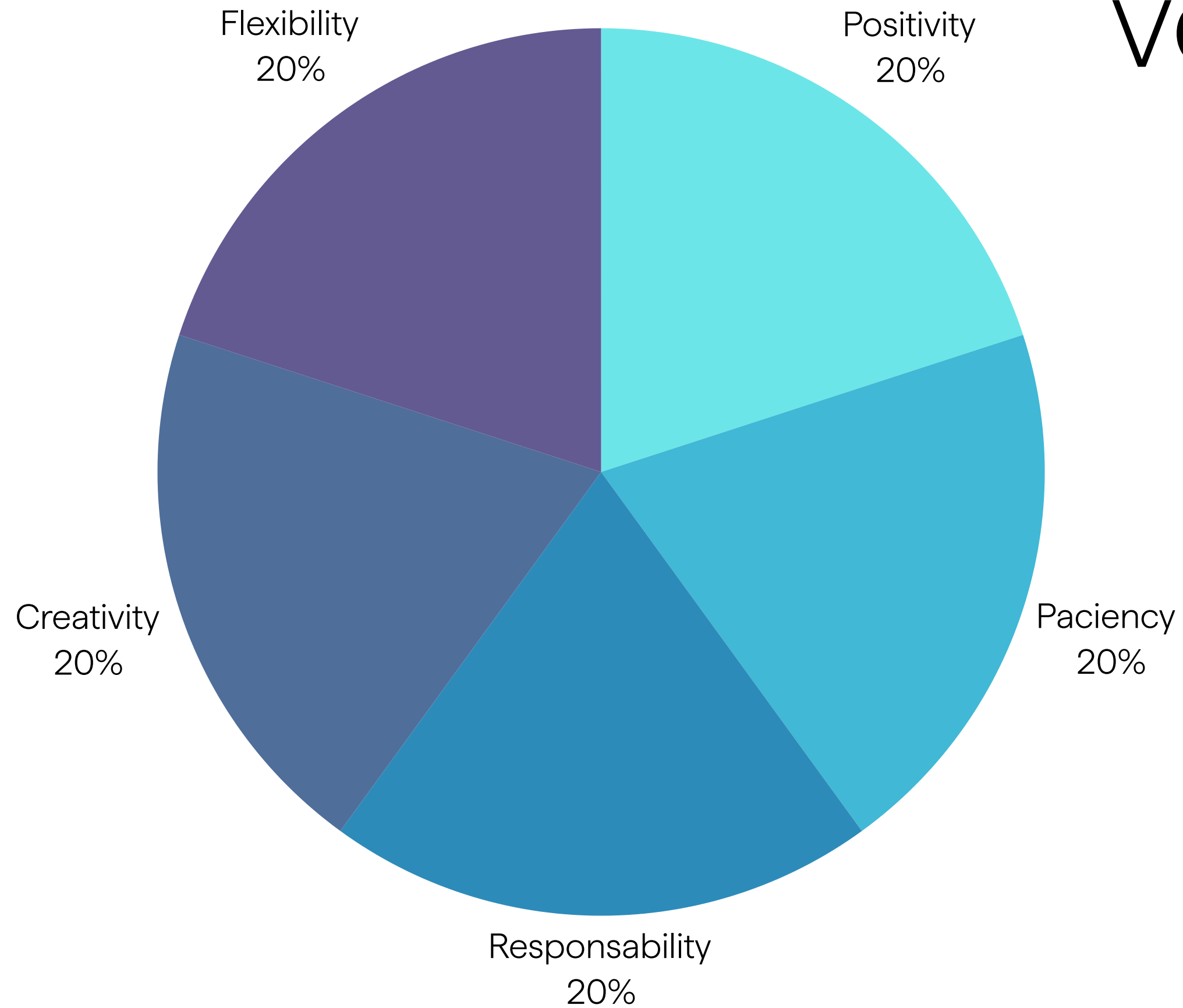

Practical arrangements

The volunteer has the right to...

- Be reimbursed for travelling expenses.
- Get a health insurance.
- Get 300€/month as pocket money on your personal credit card.
- Get the mentoring service: each month we will get individual or grupal meetings.
- Volunteer during 5 days/week (never less than 25 hours, either more than 35 hours).





Accommodation

The volunteer's accommodation will be in a private flat in Tàrrega town centre. Every volunteer will have their own bedroom and they will share kitchen, living room and bathroom with other ESC volunteers..

Housework will be shared among all members in the flat. The volunteer is allowed to invite local friends occasionally but they cannot sleep there.

Tàrrega

Tàrrega is a small city in the province of Lleida in Catalunya.

Aproximately one hour and a half from Barcelona you can find wide range of cultural, sports and leisure activities that can be done in the city.

In summer it is usually hot around 30-40 degrees.

In winter the temperature is cold less then 5-10 degrees and lots of foggy days.

The primary language spoken is Catalan, as it is the official language of the region and part of our daily life and culture.

However, everyone here also speaks Spanish fluently. It could also be a great chance for you to experience the rich bilingual culture of Catalonia.
