With around 486.000 citizen, it's one of the largest Polish cities.

The Kindergarten Complex No. 3 in Gdańsk consists of two nearby buildings in the Przymorze district, offering a safe and enriching environment for 180 children aged 3 to 6. A dedicated team of teachers and staff supports their cognitive, social, emotional, and physical development through structured activities and outdoor play. The kindergarten embraces inclusivity, welcoming children with special needs and migrant backgrounds. It engages in European programs and cultural exchanges, fostering diversity and lifelong learning.

The volunteer at the Kindergarten Complex No. 3 in Gdańsk would assist teachers in daily activities, helping children aged 3 to 6 with language learning, creative play, and physical exercises. They would support individual children, especially those with special educational needs, and introduce cultural elements from their home country through storytelling, games, and interactive projects. Additionally, the volunteer would participate in organizing events like Intercultural Days, update the kindergarten's website with activity reports, and engage with parents and staff to promote international exchange. Their role would focus on fostering a diverse, engaging, and inclusive learning environment.

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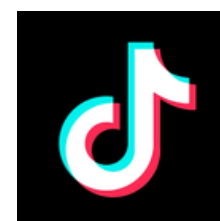
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
